OLD BUSINESS:

1. Approval of October 3, 2017 minutes.
2. Motion to amend ordinance 711 with the committee as a whole meeting change recommendation, changing in the first paragraph of page 13 of the ordinance, "Starting pay can be negotiated for new hires in levels nine (9) through twelve (12), based on experience and certification needed for the job description. Though starting pay shall be no more than five percent (5%) above starting of level" to 30%, instead of 5%.
3. Adopt amended ordinance 711 on second and final reading. An ordinance revising the existing personnel policies and procedures.
4. Adopt Ordinance 712 on second and final reading, an ordinance amending the official zoning map to rezone the Dale Hix property on the Northeast side of the Intersection of Walton Ave. and Freeman St., from I1 Light Industrial to R-2 High Density Residential District.
