**OLD BUSINESS:**

1. Approval of January 2, 2018 council minutes.
2. Adopt Ordinance 715 on second and final reading, an ordinance to amend the official zoning map of Lafayette. Said amendment rezones the WD60-a Tenn General, Dewayne Cothron and Mike Whittemore property on state Highway 52 East, from R-1 Low Density Residential to C-2 General Business District.

**NEW BUSINESS**

1. Paul Day, Shriners representative, to get authorization for annual Shriner paper sale weekend.
2. Authorization to pay Mid Tenn Engineering, the design fees for the Lafayette Technology Campus SIA Road project. Fees will be 4% of the total construction cost.
3. Mayor Jones, to discuss authorization to pay matching money for CDBG extending the city's existing county waterlines.
4. Adopt Resolution 02-06-2018A, a plan of service resolution for John Cothron's annexation request.
5. Adopt Resolution 02-06-2018B for a county waterline, to approve the city's participation for the matching funds.
6. Adopt Ordinance 716 on first reading. An ordinance to amend the 2017/2018 utility fund water department budget, needed to purchase the Farley property and Industrial Park fund, to fund the engineering services for the Industrial Park access road project.

7. Adopt Ordinance 717 on first reading, an ordinance amending title 15, "Motor Vehicles", Chapter 1, "Miscellaneous", Section 15-127 "Adoption of State Traffic Statutes". This ordinance is to reflect the state requirements of this section of the city's code.
8. Adopt Ordinance 718 on first reading, an ordinance amending title 12, "Building, Utility, etc. Codes", Chapter 5, "Residential Code", Section 12-501 "Residential Code Adopted", explaining residential sprinklers requirements.
9. Discuss allowing Verizon to install cellular telephone equipment on top of the city water tank located on Sneed Boulevard, close to Tennplasco. A picture of the equipment on a water tower is in packet.
10. Authorization to hire, Laura Ward, city hall cashier/assistant payroll clerk, at \$13.05 per hour, level 6.
11. Mayor Driver, updates on current activities.
