1. Approval of March 6, 2018 council meeting minutes.
2. Adopt Ordinance 719 on second and final reading. An ordinance amending title 19, "electricity and gas", Chapter 2, "gas", section 19-207, "fees", of the municipal code.

NEW BUSINESS

3. County Mayor Steve Jones, to discuss putting a half-cent local option sales tax increase on the November ballot.
4. Adopt Resolution 04-03-20018, a resolution to annex the John Cothron property.
5. Adopt Ordinance 720 on first reading. An ordinance to amend the official zoning map of the City of Lafayette, Tennessee. Said amendment to zone newly annexed area.
6. Adopt Ordinance 721 on first reading. An ordinance adding a 1% COLA to "Exhibit A", the pay scale levels.
7. Adopt Ordinance 722 on first reading. An ordinance adopting a 2018/2019 fiscal year budget and 2018 tax rate. Due to a reappraisal this year, the property tax rate will be a certified rate set by the state, (the tax rate on the ordinance will need to be changed before the last reading).
8. Approve opening the city pool and hire lifeguards upon the personnel committee's approval.
9. Authorization to increase the city pool admission from \$3.00 to \$5.00 per person.
10. Motion to give authorization to pay off two water department loans; titled DWSRF, \$226,825 and DWA 09-081, \$1,161,924, as certificate of deposits become due.

11. Approve installation of a six-inch waterline on Butler Rd., expense to be in 2018/2019 fiscal year budget.
12. Authorization to re-appoint Rick Gann as a Lafayette Housing Authority Commissioner, a five-year term.
13. Accept part-time Dispatcher Sierra Taylor's letter of resignation.
14. Authorization to promote Ethan Mungle to gas dept. Service Person II, from level 6 to level 7, pay from \$13.64 to \$15.00.
15. Authorization to promote Kyle Reid to Driver/Collector II, from level 6 to level 7, pay from \$13.35 to \$15.00.
